FROM THE PASTOR

LENT 2026

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we prepare to start the season of Lent, may the Grace and Peace of God Our Father and of His Son our Lord Jesus Christ be with you! Pope Leo XIV has designated this year as a Jubilee Year of Saint Francis to mark 800 years since his death. His decree



links acts of devotion to concrete intentions so that hearts may be moved toward Christian charity and authentic desires for peace among all families and peoples. This present age is not unlike Francis' own: a time when charity grows cold, social conflict becomes habitual, and peace appears increasingly fragile. The Franciscan message, far from being obsolete, requires renewed urgency especially in this tumultuous climate that we live in. "Lord, make me a channel of your peace..."

The theme for our Lenten preaching series is: *Becoming Missionary Disciples - a Journey through Lent: Fasting, Prayer, Almsgiving, Reconciliation and Peace*. Our goal is to focus on how parishioners can strengthen their faith, hope and love by practicing the spiritual and corporal works of mercy, as well as helping to evangelize and bring people "back to church." Recently, there has been a resurgence of so many people, especially famous stars and sports figures, discovering and rediscovering their Christian faith. I do not think this is a mere coincidence, but an opportunity afforded to us through grace.

What can you do this Lent to join in this movement? Begin your journey by receiving ashes on Ash Wednesday. This marks you with the sign of the cross letting everyone know you are Catholic. Attend Mass. Go to Confession. Pray. Join us for a weekday Mass in person or watch via livestream. Attend Stations of the Cross and help those in need by volunteering or contributing to a charity that is important to you. Experiencing a good Lent can really be that simple.

FAST AND ABSTINENCE & OTHER ACTS OF PENANCE LENT

The Bishops of the U.S. prescribe as minimal obligation:

- ◊ All persons who are 14 years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, on all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.
- ◊ All persons 18 years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, while the other two meals are to be light.
- ◊ All faithful are encouraged to participate at Mass and to receive the Holy Eucharist daily, to celebrate frequently the Sacrament of Penance, to undertake spiritual reading, especially the study of the Sacred Scriptures, and to participate in parish Lenten devotions and education programs.

LENT PREACHING SERIES THEME

Becoming Missionary Disciples - a Journey through Lent: Fasting, Prayer, Almsgiving, Reconciliation and Peace

Week I – Take a Journey/Pilgrimage through the desert.

Week II – We exercise through fasting.

Week III – We travel through prayer.

Week IV – We practice through almsgiving.

Week V – We experience through reconciliation.

Week VI – Palm Sunday – We promote a kingdom of peace.

Easter Sunday – Our hope is in the resurrection and we await with joy.

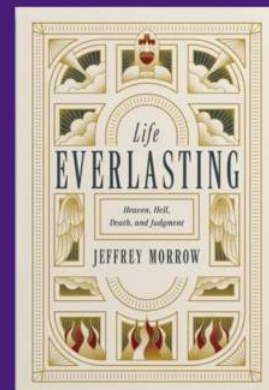

Relics of Christ's Passion.
Having the opportunity to be in the
presence of these holy relics is sure
to be an experience
that will help you connect
with the very roots of your faith.
Take advantage of what is likely to
be a once in a lifetime opportunity
to engage in a meditative walk to
Calvary and venerate these rare
and holy relics. This powerful
program is a 60-minute
meditational experience supported
with Eucharistic Exposition, music
and prayer. Veneration of the relics
will be available before and after
the program.

A collection such as this is generally
seen only in Rome or the Holy Land.
This presentation is being brought
to us as part of a collaborative
initiative between the Knights of
Columbus and the Apostolate for
Holy Relics.

The Relics of the Passion collection includes:

- A piece of the True Cross (discovered by St. Helena)
- A piece of the Holy Table from the room where the Last Supper took place
- A piece of the Column of Flagellation
- A piece of the Crown of Thorns
- Relics of the Holy Apostles
- A replica of the Holy Nail, fashioned using filings from the true nails
- A relic (bone) of St. Longinus, the centurion who pierced the side of Christ
- A picture of (the effigy of) the Veil of Veronica touched to the original with a Vatican seal attesting to the fact.
- A piece of the exterior wrapping for the Shroud of Turin

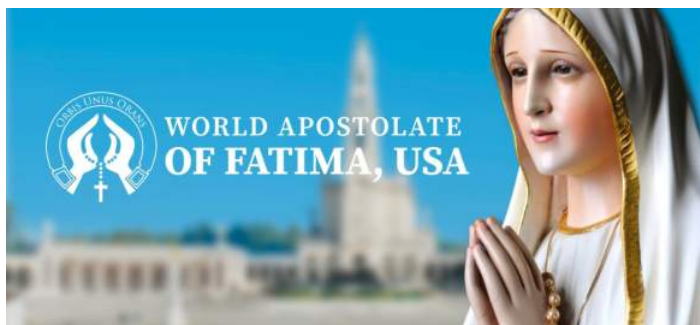

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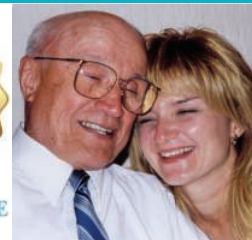
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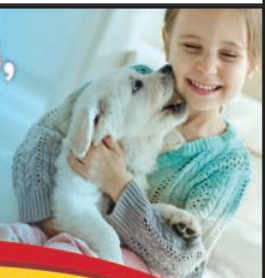


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
