Unaccompanied Minors Need Foster Homes

Bethany Christian Services who brought our Syrian families to us are now seeking help with another, even needier population: unaccompanied minors.

In the midst of the refugee crisis, many children find themselves alone. Some become separated from family during long and dangerous journeys, others are sent alone with traffickers and smugglers by parents desperate to deliver their children to safe havens; others still are orphans.

Bethany Christian services is the one agency in PA serving unaccompanied refugee minors. They are seeking foster parents to take in a young person and others to make a smaller commitment of being a mentor or tutor. Sometimes a congregation has one family as the foster family while others in the community provide additional supports.







A new ministry for men.

A new men's ministry is starting and it is a response to Jesus' words in Matthew 25:35-36: "For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me."

This ministry is a unique opportunity for you to give hope to men incarcerated in the NJ State Prison, Trenton. OLG is partnering with volunteers from other parishes under the leadership of Elizabeth Gnam, the Catholic Chaplain at the prison.

You do not need any special skills or ability— just a desire to live the Gospel more fully. You will be the only contact many of these men have had as they are often cut off from any contact by their own families. Besides visiting individuals in their locked cells, you will also meet in the prison chapel for common prayer with other inmates and share the Word and Eucharist.

Are you apprehensive about participating? It is only natural, however, it is safe and the insight, satisfaction and joy you will receive is far more than you will give. The visits will be on Friday mornings, 8:45 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. and to be a part of this ministry you do not have to be available every Friday, just as often as you wish. 
