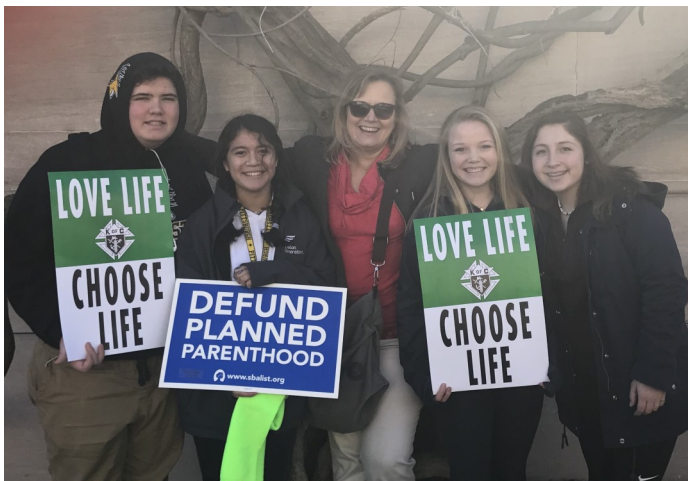

Refugee Resettlement

Unaccompanied Minors Need Foster Homes

Bethany Christian Services who brought Syrian families to us are now seeking help with another, even needier population: unaccompanied minors.

In the midst of the refugee crisis, many children find themselves alone. Some become separated from family during long and dangerous journeys, others are sent alone with traffickers and smugglers by parents desperate to deliver their children to safe havens; others still are orphans.

Bethany Christian services is the one agency in Pennsylvania serving unaccompanied refugee minors. They are seeking foster parents to take in a young person and others to make a smaller commitment of being a mentor or tutor. Sometimes a congregation make take on responsibility: one family is the foster family while others in the community provide additional supports.
