Death (& Resurrection)

Weekend of November 7 and 8

"Death puts an end to human life as the time open to either accepting or rejecting the divine grace manifested in Christ" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, paragraph 1021). This Sunday, we'll focus on the mystery of death and how we, as believers in Christ, can face death with hope, hope in eternal life. Through His Passion, Death, and Resurrection, Christ has conquered death forever and, through Baptism, we are invited to share in that victory. While death brings the separation of soul and body, our faith assures us that Christ will raise up our bodies, sharing in the glory of His Resurrection.

Hell, Weekend of November 14 and 15

While Heaven is the state of perfect happiness, Hell is the exact opposite. As St. Paul tells us, "*God desires all to be saved*" (1 Timothy 2:4). However, God, out of His great love for us, respects our freedom and allows us to choose whether to spend eternity with Him in Heaven or exclude ourselves from Him in Hell, a state of eternal separation from God. This Sunday we'll shed light on what the Bible, and Church Teaching say about Hell and how to avoid it.

Judgment, Weekend of November 21 and 22

As the Gospel of this Sunday's celebration of the Solemnity of Christ the King reveals to us, each person will stand before God and offer an account of how they served God and neighbor during their life on earth. Our God is a Merciful Lord as well as a Just Judge. This Sunday, we'll focus on how to prepare for our judgment before the Lord and offer practical ways to hear the words, "*Come, you who are blessed by my Father. Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world*" (Matthew 25:34).

Who is Peter Faber?

Peter Faber was born to a peasant family on April 13th 1506 in the village of Villaret in the Duchy of Savoy, Holy Roman Empire.

His childhood and education aspirations lead him ultimately in attendance of the University of Paris. While at university, Peter Faber met, befriended and became roommates with Ignatius of Loyola and Francis Xavier. Faber and Xavier received their Masters of Arts degrees on the same day in 1503. All three men are recognized by Jesuits as founders of the Society of Jesus.

On December 17, 2013, Pope Francis canonized Saint Peter Faber SJ. Faber is regarded as one of Pope Francis' favorite saints, and thought to be the patron saint of small business. He held the belief that a local economy was an integral facet in the lives of a community.

Among his many legacies, The School of Business at Australian Catholic University also known as the Peter Faber School of Business.
