FROM THE PASTOR

FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT - THE HEALING POWER OF GOD'S MERCY

This week's reading from Genesis on Original Sin reveals to us the identity and meaning of our brokenness, and in this light provides the essential context for understanding the real meaning of divine mercy. The first part of the reading from Genesis (2:7-9) portrays us as beings made in and for communion, and then shows that original sin is most fundamentally a rupture or severing of that communion. This is first a rupture of our communion with God, then of our own internal and personal unity, then of the relationship between man and woman, and finally a rupture of communion with the rest of created reality. Mercy is precisely the overabundant restoration of the relationships we have willfully sundered: "For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so, through the obedience of the one, the many will be made righteous" (Rom 5:19). The serpent originally tested the extent of our faith and obedience to God's promises in the Garden of Eden, a test that we failed spectacularly. Christ's obedient faith in the face of the temptations in the desert gratuitously reverses the rupture of our relationships. Mercy is most basically the restoration of relationship: "For if by the transgression of the one, the many died, *how much more* did the grace of God and the gracious gift of the one man Jesus Christ *overflow* for the many" (Rom 5:15).



PARISHIONER STORY - BLOOD DONATIONS: THE LIFELINE TODAY, FOR THE HOPE OF TOMORROW

There are a multitude of reasons why people should donate blood. The closest one to us is the continuing need of individuals who are transfusion-dependent for an entire lifetime! We have a son who was born with a blood condition known as Thalassemia Major (Cooley's Anemia). He has a genetic deficiency whereby he is unable to produce life-sustaining blood cells capable of supporting vital organs, such as the liver, heart and spleen. He is transfused every three weeks in order to live. Even so, the quality of his life is compromised, and he requires additional medication to combat iron overload to his organs.

In our younger days (when we had more stamina), we were actively engaged in recruiting blood for Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. What we can now do, however, is to simply urge parishioners to donate their blood in the upcoming OLG drive. It is the right thing to do. God Bless You.
