Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Pope Leo XIV has designated this year as a Jubilee Year of Saint Francis to mark 800 years since his death. This present age is not unlike Francis' own: a time when charity grows cold, social conflict becomes habitual, and peace appears increasingly fragile. The Franciscan message, far from being obsolete, requires renewed urgency especially in this tumultuous climate that we live in. "Lord, make me a channel of your peace...".

Our Lenten preaching series goal is to focus on how parishioners can strengthen their faith, hope and love by practicing the spiritual and corporal works of mercy, as well as helping to evangelize and bring people "back to church."


POOR MAN'S SUPPER RAISES MONEY FOR FACE TO FACE

SEMI-ANNUAL PARISH FINANCIAL UPDATE, MARCH 7 AND 8, 2026

On behalf of the Parish Finance Council and Monsignor Gentili, following is our semi-annual financial update. Please know that we are profoundly grateful for the spiritual and financial support continually demonstrated by our parishioners. Your support is truly a source of inspiration to us all.

Our Sunday collection goal is **\$36,000 per week**. This goal is necessary to maintain our day-to-day operations, our dedicated staff, and our beautiful parish campus. A number of expenses continue to increase, including property insurance, salaries, medical insurance, and utilities, to name a few. We hope to achieve this weekly collection goal during the current fiscal year with our strong financial oversight and **your** help.

We are **35 weeks** into the fiscal year, which ends on June 30. Our weekly collection remains flat in comparison to last year, with an average weekly collection of **\$33,367**. If you are fortunate enough to find yourself in a position to **begin** contributing or to **increase** your contribution, we kindly ask you to consider doing so.

If you have not already done so, we encourage you to sign up **today** for **Parish Giving**, our electronic offertory program (*egiving*), which currently represents **61%** of parishioner contributions received on a weekly basis. We would like to increase *egiving* to **65%** by this time next year. We are pleased to offer the **Parish Giving** app, the link on the website, and the QR code, to donate easily. The QR code can be found in the bulletin, on the Narthex monitors during mass, and on the bottom of your screen during livestream.

Our parish benefits greatly by being able to count on that same level of financial support, each- and- every week. We wanted to give special thanks to those who use **Parish Giving** and mail-in their donations. When the snowy weather caused limited mass attendance, *egiving* and mail-in donations were essential and validate the importance of these methods of giving. Nevertheless, we are **truly and profoundly grateful** for whatever method you choose to consistently give in support of **your** parish.



Our Stewardship Campaign was once again **very** successful. We thank the 382 parish families who donated \$212,660. These financial resources help us fund parish ministries and services, help those in need at local charities and maintain our beloved Church campus.

We continue to thrive and flourish with the celebration of the sacraments, including a growing number of Weddings, Marriage Blessings, First Holy Communions, and Confirmations. Our Order of Christian Initiation for Adults (OCIA) is expanding and our support for those who have lost their loved ones is as important as ever. We have seen an increase in those attending our various bible study classes. Weekday and Sunday mass attendance continues to strengthen. We have seen a boost in the number of young families with children attending mass, especially at the 9 a.m. Children’s Liturgy. Ash Wednesday was notably crowded at every mass.

We ask each of you to help welcome back parishioners and encourage new parishioners to join our OLG family, that personal invitation really does make a difference, and helps us live our mission statement *to be a vibrant welcoming parish family dedicated to growing disciples and making Church matter.*

The chart below shows the parishioner levels of giving. Please take a look to see where you are and perhaps, consider moving up a “step.” The reality is that we **need** the financial resources **you** provide to achieve the spiritual objectives we are so proud of and that define who we are as a Parish. For that, we humbly thank you. Thank you also for your continued example of faith and commitment to our wonderful Parish. May God bless you and your families.



FAST AND ABSTINENCE & OTHER ACTS OF PENANCE LENT

The Bishops of the U.S. prescribe as minimal obligation:

- ◇ All persons who are 14 years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, on all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.
- ◇ All persons 18 years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, while the other two meals are to be light.
- ◇ All faithful are encouraged to participate at Mass and to receive the Holy Eucharist daily, to celebrate frequently the Sacrament of Penance, to undertake spiritual reading, especially the study of the Sacred Scriptures, and to participate in parish Lenten devotions and education programs.
