

FROM THE PASTOR



MESSAGE ON MASS ATTENDANCE FOR CHRISTMAS 2020 – THOUGHTS TO CONSIDER

One of the highlights of our liturgical life is the celebration of the Birth of our Savior Jesus Christ on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. Each year so many of you come together and come to Church for this celebration. However, as has been the case for so many other liturgical celebrations during the COVID-19 pandemic, we have had to curtail and adjust our gatherings. And so, as we approach this Christmas, continued vigilance is warranted. Here at OLG we continue to be prudent by following the safety guidelines and protocols of the CDC, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Bucks County Health Department and the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. Your cooperation has been and will continue to be greatly appreciated. I am most grateful to God that we have been able to come together each day during the week and weekends to celebrate Mass and receive the Holy Eucharist, while still maintaining the required precautions in order to keep everyone safe and healthy.

As you prepare for the celebration of Christmas may I be so bold as to invite you to consider participating in our celebrations at Christmas time. I offer the following thoughts for you to reflect upon in regard to how that participation might take place.

■ As you may be aware, the faithful continue to be dispensed by the Archbishop from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation until further notice. That being stated, I encourage you at a minimum to plan on those occasions to gather as family and join us via livestream through our website or Facebook. For your information all our Weekday Masses and the 8 a.m. Sunday Mass are recorded each week and are available to watch at another time that may be more convenient to you. We will be livestreaming all of our Christmas Masses. You may also be aware of the many other opportunities for Mass on other websites or television, i.e. the Cathedral Basilica of SS Peter and Paul or EWTN as just two of many examples.

MESSAGE ON MASS ATTENDANCE CONTINUED

■ We continue to follow all guidelines of the institutions mentioned above, with appropriate cleaning of high touch surfaces in the church after each use, sanitizing our hands as we enter and leave the Church, wearing face masks or coverings appropriately and social distancing. It may interest you to know that since June, when churches were re-opened for the public celebration of Mass, there has not been a known, traceable instance of contracting COVID-19 through attending Mass or receiving Holy Communion at OLG, nor the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, for that matter.



■ If large gatherings continue to cause you fear, might you consider attending Mass at some other time of the week, when the congregation is much smaller? Remember for us as Christians we celebrate the Octave of Christmas, and so consider making your celebration by attending Mass on one of the days throughout the Octave or possibly during the traditional “Twelve Days of Christmas”? While not officially twelve days from Christmas, the Solemnity of the Epiphany is celebrated here in the United States on the nearest Sunday to those twelve days, which is January 3rd this year. For your information liturgically, the Christmas Season extends to the following Sunday, January 10th, the Solemnity of the Baptism of the Lord. If our particular Mass schedule does not meet your family’s schedule, might you consider attending Mass at one of the other parishes in the area or the Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa? All other schedules are published on the appropriate websites.

■ While as a religious institution, we are permitted to have as many as a 75% occupancy for our church we cannot do that with social distancing. At this time to maintain social distancing our maximum occupancy for the church is approximately 600. This includes using the Our Lady of Guadalupe Shrine area, the Saint Juan Diego Chapel and the Narthex. Additionally, for Christmas Eve and day, we will make use of livestreaming the Masses on the monitors in the Saint John XXIII Social Hall and Holy Family Lobby at the Parish Life Center (PLC). When the church reaches capacity, you will be directed to watch Mass in the PLC or you can watch via livestream in your car (and receive Communion after Mass).

■ All of the above having been stated, here is our Mass schedule for you to consider:

**Christmas Eve Masses at 3:30 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.
Christmas Day Masses at 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.
We will be livestreaming all of our Christmas Masses.**

■ Should you have any questions you may contact the office, and someone will be available to assist you. Be sure to always be healthy and stay safe by being prudent in your judgments and decisions; remember that exercising caution is most often the better part of valor. God bless you and your family. Father Ianelli and I look forward to seeing you during the holy days of Christmas.

A PASTORAL MESSAGE FROM ARCHBISHOP NELSON J. PÉREZ ON THE SEASON OF ADVENT

This year, perhaps more than ever, we need Christmas and its promise of hope for a suffering humanity in the person of Jesus Christ. To fully understand and be ready to accept that profound gift on Christmas day, we must prepare our minds and hearts. If we embrace the Season of Advent fully, we will be ready for the Savior. Though our Advent experience may be far from typical this year due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this holy season can still be one of prayer and charity.

At the Angelus this past weekend, Pope Francis said, “Advent is a continuous call to hope: it reminds us that God is present in history to lead it to its ultimate goal and to lead us to its fullness, which is the Lord, the Lord Jesus Christ.”

Soon we will rejoice in celebration of the birth of our Lord Jesus in Bethlehem, remembering the words of Saint Matthew, “Behold, the virgin shall be with child and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel, which means, ‘God is with us.’” As we direct our lives more fully toward the Lord Jesus during these days of preparation, let us pray for and encourage one another in our efforts to be people of hope.


