

FROM THE PASTOR

HEAD OF U.S. BISHOPS COMMENTS ON SUPREME COURT DECISION REFERENCING ‘SEX’

‘Our sex, whether we are male or female, is part of God’s plan for creation and for our lives’

June 16, 2020

The president of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), Archbishop José H. Gomez of Los Angeles, provided a statement on the decision issued today by the *Supreme Court of the United States – combining Bostock v. Clayton County, Ga., Altitude Express v. Zarda, and R.G. & G.R. Harris Funeral Homes v. Equal Opportunity Employment Comm’n.*



The justices ruled that the prohibition on “sex” discrimination in employment in Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 now prohibits discrimination based on “sexual orientation” and “transgender” status.

Archbishop Gomez’s statement follows:

I am deeply concerned that the U.S. Supreme Court has effectively redefined the legal meaning of ‘sex’ in our nation’s civil rights law. This is an injustice that will have implications in many areas of life.

By erasing the beautiful differences and complementary relationship between man and woman, we ignore the glory of God’s creation and harm the human family, the first building block of society. Our sex, whether we are male or female, is part of God’s plan for creation and for our lives. As Pope Francis has taught with such sensitivity, to live in the truth with God’s intended gifts in our lives requires that we receive our bodily and sexual identity with gratitude from our Creator. No one can find true happiness by pursuing a path that is contrary to God’s plan.


Every human person is made in the image and likeness of God and, without exception, must be treated with dignity, compassion, and respect. Protecting our neighbors from unjust discrimination does not require redefining human nature. We pray that the Church, with the help of Mary, the Mother of God, will be able to continue her mission to bring Jesus Christ to every man and woman.

GUIDELINES FOR RETURNING TO MASS



GENERAL POINTS

- ♦ The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation continues to be lifted during the Yellow Phase. You are not required to attend Mass at this time.
- ♦ Please stay home if you are sick and if you are at higher risk of severe illness with COVID19. If you are uncertain about your risk status, please consult your doctor/CDC Guidelines.
- ♦ Mass will continue to be available via livestream. Beginning this weekend, the 5 p.m. Saturday Vigil Mass will be livestreamed on the parish website :

- ♦ Daily Mass (Monday through Saturday) at 8 a.m. will be held in the Church. The parish is planning to offer livestream of the Daily Mass from the church in the future.
- ♦ Since the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays has been lifted, please consider attending any Mass during the week/weekend to receive Our Lord in the Holy Eucharist.

MASS SCHEDULE -All Masses will be at the Church.

Vigil Mass, 5 p.m. Saturday Evening (also livestreamed)
Sunday Masses, 9 a.m. and 11 a.m.
Daily Mass, Monday through Saturday, 8 a.m.

BEFORE COMING TO MASS

- ♦ Please wash your hands for 20 seconds using soap and water.
- ♦ **Before entering the Church, please sanitize your hands and put on a face mask or cloth covering.** Your face mask/cloth covering **must remain on** throughout the entire Mass. Exceptions to this are “children younger than 2 years old, anyone who has trouble breathing or is unconscious, and anyone who is incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove the cloth face covering without assistance” (CDC Guidelines).
- ♦ Missals will not be in the pews during this period. You may bring your own missal/readings with you or view online.

ENTERING THE CHURCH

- ♦ Church doors will be kept open until the Church has reached a safe number of attendees to maintain social distancing.
- ♦ Hand sanitizers will be available at the Church entrances.

SEATING

- ♦ Please honor all posted signs about where you may sit. Pews will be marked with tape to assist with social distancing guidelines. Ushers will assist to ensure proper social distancing.
- ♦ Members of the same household may sit together as normal. Keep six feet between your household and others.

DURING MASS

- ♦ There will be no Sign of Peace during Mass during the Yellow Phase and no holding hands during the Our Father.
- ♦ The Precious Blood will not be distributed during Mass during the Yellow Phase.

RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

- ♦ There will be three single communion lines during weekend Masses and ushers will provide instruction.
- ♦ Please maintain social distancing in the Communion line. Keep several pews between yourself and the person in front of you while in line and when returning to your pew.
- ♦ The faithful are asked to receive Holy Communion in the hand. If someone wishes to receive on their tongue, the priest or Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion will immediately sanitize their hands, before resuming distribution.
- ♦ Keep your mask on while walking up the aisle to receive Holy Communion and remove only to receive Holy Communion.

EXITING THE CHURCH

- ♦ At the conclusion of Mass, please exit the Church from all doors and proceed directly to your car. Do not congregate.
- ♦ Ushers will not hand out the parish bulletin. Please take one from tables in the Church. Leave your mask on until you exit.

OUR COMMITMENT TO YOU

Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish will follow the guidelines from the CDC for sanitation as we resume public Masses.

- ♦ Every day our church is completely sanitized which includes the wiping down of the top of every pew, cleaning the bathrooms and wiping all frequently used areas such as door handles and light switches. This entire cleaning will also be done between each Mass.




